On Independence Day, Armenia marks the anniversary of the September 21, 1991 referendum in which the people of Armenia voted to secede from the Soviet Union. The following November, Levon Ter-Petrosyan became the first president of sovereign Armenia.

Special events are held all over the country that glorify Armenian history and culture, and on the anniversary dates from the day of the declaration of independence, a large military parade can be observed in Yerevan.
